

Jan van der Struik leaves NN for CCS

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Jan van der Struik (49), previously Director of the Retail Non-Life division at Nationale Nederlanden, recently took up the position of Commercial Director at software supplier CCS. He will also become a member of the CCS Executive Board.

Jan van der Struik has extensive experience in the financial sector, having exercised various management roles within Nationale Nederlanden (part of the NN Group), RVS Verzekeringen (part of ING Verzekeren Benelux), ING Bank and Rabobank.

In his most recent post at Nationale Nederlanden, Jan was responsible for the retail non-life division and supervised a number of complex change projects. Prior to this, he was Director of the regional bank insurance team at Nationale Nederlanden.

In his new position as Commercial Director at CCS, Jan van der Struik will be responsible for developing the commercial strategy of the Woerden-based software company, both nationally and internationally, and he will be leading the sales teams.
